How We're Keeping You Safe

Thank you for staying with us! Your health and safety is our top priority. We are following all Lake County Public Health Agency guidelines to help ensure your room is sparkling clean and your stay is safe.

How We're Cleaning

- Before you check in, we thoroughly clean your room and then leave it unoccupied for at least 24 hours.
- We disinfect high-touch surfaces in your room and in common areas and make hand sanitizer available.
- We wash all linens on high heat and disinfect laundry hampers.
- We even sanitize credit cards, pens, and room keys after each use.

What Else We're Doing to Keep You Safe

- We will give you face coverings, gloves, and disinfectant wipes at your request.
- We're checking all employees for COVID-19 symptoms, and any sick employee stays at home.
- All employees are required to wear a cloth face covering. All housekeeping staff are required to wear face coverings and disposable gloves.
