



### DON'T USE WET TRAILS

If you are leaving prints (tire or boot), the trail is too wet to use. If you encounter muddy spots, go through the center of the mud to keep the trail narrow.

### STAY ON THE TRAIL

Protect plants and the homes of local wildlife by riding in the center of the trail and not cutting switchbacks.

### DON'T BLOCK THE TRAIL


Move to the side of the trail when taking a break.
